Interior Sheen Guide

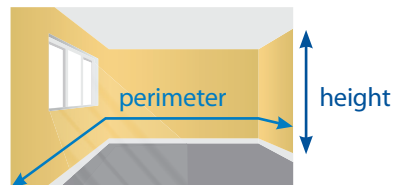
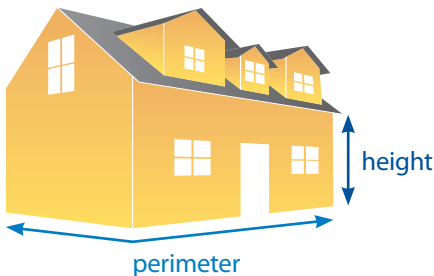
Where to Use	Sheen
Living Rooms, Dining Rooms, Bedrooms	Flat
Hallways, Kids Rooms, Family Rooms, Kitchens, Doors, Trim	Eggshell/Satin
Kitchens, Bathrooms, Doors, Trim	Semi-Gloss
Doors, Trim, Cabinets	Gloss

Exterior Sheen Guide

Where to Use	Sheen
Exterior Walls	Flat
Exterior Walls, Doors, Trim	Satin
Doors, Trim	Semi-Gloss
Doors, Trim, Shutters, Railings	Gloss

Paint Calculator *(1 gallon = approximately a 10'x12' room)*

- **Measure** the perimeter around the room or house in feet (be sure to subtract any doors or windows when estimating paint coverage)
- **Multiply** by the height of the room or house for your total square footage
- **Divide** by the coverage rate shown on the paint label

Preparing to Paint

- primer
- ladder
- paint scraper and blades
- drop cloth
- painter's tape
- wall cleaner
- spackle and putty knife
- caulk and caulking gun
- wood filler
- screwdriver
- disposable latex gloves
- stir sticks
- sandpaper/sanding blocks
- sponges

Painting

- painting rags
- paint brushes
- angled trim paint brushes
- paint tray
- paint tray liners
- roller frame
- roller covers
- extension pole
- paint pads
- faux finishing tool

Clean-up

- appropriate solvents
(for oil-based paints)
- buckets
- shop towels

Applicator Guide

Brushes	Use
2-1/2"	interior painting
2-1/2" angled	exterior and interior trim
4"	siding

Roller Covers	Use
1/4" nap	semi or high gloss sheen paints
3/8" nap	flat or eggshell/satin sheen paints
